Recommend a grant to support the MFN. If you don't yet have a DAF but plan to give regularly, you may want to explore one.

- **Use your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD)**

If you are 73 or older, you can direct your RMD to the Foundation — transforming the required withdrawal into meaningful support.

- **Make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)**

If you are 70½ or older, you can give directly from your IRA — even before RMD age — to live your legacy sooner and potentially lower taxable income.


- **Include the Foundation in Your Legacy Plans**
